- ✓ Providing a room for the youth and children to improve and discovering their abilities and talents.
- ✓ Equipping both the youth and children with skills on how to handle difficult situations they face in different aspects of their daily life styles.
- ✓ Helping the youth and children to adopt new skills in doing different tasks in a given aspect.
- ✓ Attracting them to love the Bible and understanding how it can help in overcoming different LIFE CHALLENGES through Bible study techniques and quiz.

- The youth learnt how to get new useful friends and were given opportunities to interact together.
- The turn up was good they **375** participants.
- The accommodation was convenient to all the participant who slept at the station.

- Generally the participants were well- behaved and this made it easy for them to share their packaged messages.
- The Facilitators were flexible, friendly and managed the time well.
- **17** youth and **20** Children gave their lives to Christ among them 3 were youth and 10 children in KOP.
- The meals was well prepared and the participants were well served.
- Members who had spiritual challenges were prayed for and by grace of God were delivered.
- All the participants were awarded certificates of attendance.
- The security was good which help much to avoid immoral behavior.

CHALLENGES

We thank God who is gracious though some challenges were faced but did not sabotaged much our program. These are some of the challenges we're faced;-

- One Facilitator totally failed to facilitate due to her personal challenges.
- Public system was so challenging which sometime caused some sessions to delay and therefore we were forced to hire machines from others church.
- There was a heavy rainfall on the last day which challenged us in conducting the programs well on that day.
