The nutritional benefits of fresh milk are widely acknowledged but we know from experience that it is a nutritional source not easily obtainable in Rwanda. Support for this project has enabled the purchase of a second cow for Gahima Agape School. Most of the students board and their diet will be enhanced through greater production of milk and improved quality and quantity of fruit and veg as the manure is used to enrich the soil. Head boy Yahayo had this to say:

"...We are drinking porridge mixed with milk from the cows you gave to us and the milk is very important in our life. So we are happy and we are thanking you for everything and we are always praying God to be with you".

Danny Bimenyimana, one of our sponsored youngsters at Gahima Agape School, Kibungo wrote:

"...the cows are in our school from your support, we drink milk from those cows mixed in porridge. All students have good health, so thank you very much for everything you have done for us to promote our future... God bless you"
