28 FEBRUARY Pray for the church run schools providing for the poorest in their communities, as they struggle to implement the required Government improvements to enable them to reopen after Covid-19.

31 JANUARY Pray for every family that received a solar lamp, and for those still waiting patiently. Give thanks that homework can be completed and Bibles can be read in the evening.
