


NEWS UPDATE - AUGUST

A WHAMMY FOR KABWAMI



When we visited Kabwami school earlier this year we knew immediately that the school needed some serious help with renovation. Holes in the roof, holes in the walls and muddy floors did not make for a conducive learning space. Only one classroom had windows and a lockable door, and the children there shared it with a very valuable commodity - the wood for the school kitchen stove. Surprisingly, although a church school serving 320 children it only possessed one bible! In a very remote and poor area, the children with uniform and/or shoes were in the minority, but they all had the biggest smiles and welcomed us enthusiastically.

On returning from Uganda, CHI delved deep into the coffers and have managed to supply enough money to renovate the school, making the classrooms bigger, repairing the roof and concreting all the floors to save the children's feet from being infested with jiggers - nasty little creatures that burrow between the children's toes! We have also been able to supply a water tank so the children do not have to make the 6 km round trip each day for water. All the labour has come from the local community which gives ownership and pride in their school. By September, when Uganda hopes to open schools again, the building work will be completed - however more funds will be needed for school lunches, uniforms, scholastic materials, hygiene packs and, of course, Bibles. Sadly our pot is not bottomless so we ask for your prayers that donations keep coming in and we are able to fulfil the back to school wish list for the students of Kabwami. *Thank you!*



MEDICS ARRIVE IN KALEERE

The elderly of Kaleere in Uganda are a very special community of aging guardians of young children. When we visited in February we were astounded to see these elderly residents busying themselves building new classrooms for the school. Obviously with age, comes a variety of health concerns, so when Rev Canon Eriab asked us for some interim help with medication we were more than happy to oblige. Many of the residents were seen, some with serious illnesses were given painkillers to at least alleviate. Sadly in the last week two of the recipients have since passed on. We pray that they found some relief from their ailments in the interim.

Abdu Mivumbi, whom we were able to give treatment despite his weakness, is now improved and had this to say: *"In God, if you had not come, I would be gone by now. There was something inside me that used to pull me apart. With the medicine that I got, I no longer feel it. Thank you so much."* Sadly Abdu died on 25 July after a long battle with lung cancer - may his soul rest in peace. Abdu leaves behind a wife, they were guardians for 5 young children

Ms Jalia Namutebi (89) was actually wondering and praising God who gave you the big heart to care for them. She is so proud of being a Christian. Sadly Jalia died on 23 July - may her soul rise in Glory. Jalia leaves behind 3 young children whom she cared for.






