## Knitted and crocheted

# Child's round neck raglan Jumper Double Knitting yarn

### You will need -


250, DK yarn 3.25mm (10)knitting needles

4.00mm (8) knitting needles

4.00mm crochet hook

Stitch holders

Approx - 24"/26", 60/65cm,



#### **ABBREVIATIONS -**

**k** - knit, **p** = purl, **garter st** = every row knit, stocking st = one row knit, one row purl, st(s) = stitch(es), tog = together, **m1** = make one stitch. **vo** = varn over needle

inc = increase, psso = pass slip stitch over,

sl st = slip stitch, patt = pattern,

**beg** = beginning, **in(s)** = inch(es),

cm(s) = centimetre(s)

**ch** = chain, **dc** = double crochet,

**tr** = treble crochet

#### Back

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 77 sts.

Row 1- K1, \*p1, k1: rep from \* to end

Row 2- P1, \*k1, p1: rep from \* to end

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 12 rows

Using 4mm needles - SI1, \*k2tog, k1 rep from \* until 1 st remains k1 - 52 sts Change to 4.mm crochet hook.

Next row - slip first stitch from knitting needle onto crochet hook.

1ch, dc into same space, dc into each stitch on needle.

Row 1- 2ch, tr into every st to end, turn Row 2 - 1ch, dc into every st to end, turn



These 2 rows form the pattern continue until work measures 12" 30cm from start. Change to 4mm knitting needles.

Next row - sl1, \*inc in next stitch (work into front and back loop of crochet st), k next stitch. rep from \* till 1 st remains, k1 - 77 sts. Knit 3 rows

#### Raglan Shaping

Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows. Row 3- K1, sl1, k1 psso knit to last 3sts, K2tog, k1 Row 4- Purl \*\*\* Rep last 2 rows until 23, sts remain. Slip stitches onto a stitch holder

#### Front

Work as given for back to \*\*\*

Rep the last 2 rows until 39 sts

Working on the first 13 sts

\*\*\*\*Continue to dec 1st on armhole edge on next and every alt row, **at the same time** dec 1st on neck edge on next 4 alternate rows.

Dec at armhole edge only until 2sts remain.

Next row-P

Next row- K2tog, fasten off.

Slip next 13 sts onto a stitch holder for the neck band.

With wrong side facing rejoin yarn to neck edge and purl to end. Complete as given for first side from \*\*\*\* to end.

#### Sleeves make 2

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 38 sts.

Work 14, rows of rib as given for back.

Change to 4mm needles - SI1, \*k2tog, k1, rep from \* until 1 st remains k1 - 26 sts

Change to 4mm crochet hook

Next row - slip first stitch from knitting needle onto crochet hook. 1ch, dc into same space, dc into each stitch on needle. 26 sts

Row 1 - 2ch, tr into every st to end, turn

Row 2 - 1ch, dc into every st to end, turn

Row 3 - 2ch, 2tr in next st, tr in every st till 2 sts remain, 2tr in next st, tr in last st, turn st

Row 4 - as row 2

These 4 rows form the pattern, continue until you have 42 sts. Continue with Row 1 and Row 2 until work measures 14", 35cm

Change to 4mm knitting needles,

Next row - SI1, \*inc in next stitch, k next st, rep from \* till 1 st remains, k1 - 62sts.

Knit 3 rows

#### Raglan Shaping

Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Row 3- K1, sl1, k1, psso, knit to last 3sts k2tog, k1.

Row 4- Purl

Rep last 2 rows until 8 sts remain.

Leave these stitches on holder for neck band.

#### **Finishing**

With 3.25mm needles and right side facing, pick up and knit 8 sts from top of sleeve, 16 sts along side of neck front, 13 sts from st holder, 16 sts along side of neck front, 8 sts from top of sleeve, 23 sts from back. 84 sts.

Work 6 rows of k1, p1 rib as for back, cast off (not too tightly).

Join raglan seams, side seams and sleeve seams. Sew in ends.
